



UNIFORM GUIDELINES

All Secondary School students at Central Coast Steiner School are required to wear the uniform. We believe a student best demonstrates their individuality through their deeds and creations, rather than through their purchasing of fashionable and branded garments.

It is also important that students are sun-safe and protected for the various lesson activities they will encounter, and the school uniform provides this protection. Uniform items are available for purchase or order through the school office. Shoes, socks, hats and sport shorts will need to be purchased separately.

Uniform Year 7-10

All parts of the school uniform should be worn as intended, at the correct lengths, and be of clean and tidy condition at all times.

Lower body:

- Navy skirt, navy shorts or long navy pants. Hem lengths for skirts and shorts should be at least mid-thigh length.
- Navy stockings or full leg tights can be worn underneath skirts or shorts for extra warmth in winter.
- White socks – plain.
- Black, lace-up leather shoes. Shoes must cover full instep with plain black laces only. No soft uppers (canvas or fabric) are allowed for safety reasons. Vans and Converse will be accepted if they are FULL BLACK LEATHER (soles must be black).

Upper Body:

- White blouse or white shirt (short sleeve) with embroidered logo and trim
- White singlets or white thermals may be worn underneath shirts for extra warmth
- Polo shirt with embroidered logo – choice of eight colours. Long-sleeve undershirts of a matching colour may be worn underneath polo shirts for extra warmth.
- Navy pullover or navy cardigan with embroidered logo and trim
- Navy scarf or navy gloves may be worn for extra warmth

Hats:

- Broad-brimmed or legionnaire hats provide the best sun protection and are encouraged.
- Caps without excessive logos or branding are also acceptable.
- Beanies are optional for winter months only.

Sport:

- School-issued blue sport polo shirt
- Mid-thigh length navy blue or black sport shorts such as soccer or basketball shorts.
- Black or navy blue tights or 'skins' may be worn underneath sport shorts. Tights or 'skins' are not a substitute for shorts.
- Lace-up runners or joggers with supportive cushioned sole (no studs).
- Sport socks.



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Dress Code Year 7-10

The following dress codes apply:

- Tattoos are not permitted
- Body piercing, except for the ears, is not permitted. Limit – 2 earrings per ear. Ear stretchers are not permitted
- No facial piercings are allowed. A small clear plastic stud is required for any pre-existing facial piercings.
- Jewellery should not be excessive and needs to be removed for sport, PE and other physical activities.
- Make-up should be subtle. Excessive make-up is not permitted.

Consequences if Dress Code not followed:

- A detention may be given and/or note may be sent home if a child is dressed inappropriately.
- Make-up and/or nail polish may be removed by the student at the office and a note sent home.
- For repeated breaches, or inappropriate clothing, the parents/guardians will be advised.
- Students may be requested to change their clothing if inappropriate and may be provided with alternative clothing if necessary.

If unforeseen circumstances prevent your child wearing any part of the school uniform, it is required that you provide your child with a note explaining the reason for being out of uniform. We will endeavour to provide your child with spare items for the day and we ask it is returned washed and dried, as soon as possible.
